

Fines. At the discretion of the hearing officer, fines and/or work assignments may be imposed. If a fine is not paid, an additional case will be opened for noncompliance and an increase in the sanction will likely occur. St. Norbert also has the right to impose fines when a student commits *any* of the following violations:

| Violation | Fine and Disciplinary Response |

| Public urination | <i>Starts at \$150 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Smoking in a nonsmoking area | <i>Starts at \$150 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Failure to evacuate when fire alarm sounds | <i>Starts at \$250 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Tampering with surveillance equipment | <i>Starts at \$250 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Tampering with fire safety equipment | <i>Starts at \$250 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Pulling a fire alarm when there is no fire | <i>Starts at \$500 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Unauthorized entry to a building | <i>Starts at \$500 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |
| Unauthorized pet | <i>Starts at \$1,000 and could include fees for damages</i> |
| Unauthorized access to rooftops | <i>Starts at \$1,000 and could include suspension from SNC</i> |

Please note this grid does not include every fine possible, but gives an idea of potential fine amounts and additional sanctions.
