Program Language

All courses at Bond are taught in English, except for language instruction courses.

General Transfer Information

Please note that students must take the equivalent of a full time course load (12 credits minimum) when studying abroad to qualify for financial aid.

40 Credit Points at Bond are equivalent to 15 semester credits at St. Norbert College.

Students at Bond University will be awarded 1 additional credit if they pass the equivalent of 15 St. Norbert College semester credits.

If a student receives a grade of **F (49%)** or lower, then the student will not earn credit for that course. It will count as credits attempted, not earned, and will be reflected on the student's St. Norbert transcript as **NT (Not Transferable)**.

All courses passed while abroad transfer with a grade of **T (Transferable)**. Students do not receive the SNC equivalent grade and Bond University grades are not factored into the student's GPA. The SNC grade equivalency is provided as a courtesy for the student to better understand the minimum grade required to earn transfer credit.
