### **Program Language**

All courses at Limerick are taught in English, except for language instruction courses.

### **General Transfer Information**

Please note that students must take the equivalent of a full time course load (12 credits minimum) when studying abroad to qualify for financial aid.

30 Units at Limerick are equivalent to 15 semester credits at St. Norbert College.

Students at University of Limerick will be awarded 1 additional credit if they pass the equivalent of 15 St. Norbert College semester credits.

If a student receives a grade of **Compensating Fail (D1)** or lower, then the student will not earn credit for that course. It will count as credits attempted, not earned, and will be reflected on the student's St. Norbert transcript as **NT (Not Transferable)**.

All courses passed while abroad transfer with a grade of **T (Transferable)**. Students do not receive the SNC equivalent grade and University of Limerick grades are not factored into the student's GPA. The SNC grade equivalency is provided as a courtesy for the student to better understand the minimum grade required to earn transfer credit.
