

Graduate Student Monthly Payment Plan Options

St. Norbert College partners with **Nelnet** (an outside agency) to offer and maintain payment plans for students who wish to pay their out-of-pocket expense with a monthly payment. Students can set up automatic withdrawal from a checking/savings account or credit/debit card. Payments made by credit/debit card are subject to a processing fee of 2.85 percent. Nelnet will withdraw the monthly payment automatically on the first of each month. Once the funds have cleared the bank, the payment will be forward it to St. Norbert College to be applied to the student's account.

To enroll in an Academic Year plan, you must estimate your total out-of-pocket amount for both fall and spring semesters. Payments plans begin on Aug. 1 so be sure to enroll early. **For enrollment deadlines please go to <https://mycollegepaymentplan.com/snc/>**

Note: J-Term and summer expenses should not be included when determining your amount for the payment plan. Any J-Term tuition and fees are due Jan. 2, and any summer tuition and fees are due June 2.

Students enrolled in the Nelnet Monthly Payment Plan will continue to receive monthly billing notifications by email from St. Norbert College. This allows students to compare their semester balance with the amount budgeted on the Nelnet Payment Plan. All semester balances must be paid in full after the final monthly payment of the semester (December for fall and May for spring). Students may adjust their Nelnet Payment Plan Budget at any time.
